- Teach 9-12 Credit hours per semester (School is an Adjunct University)
 - Courses taught include Fundamentals of Costume Design, Costume Design 1, Costume Design 2, Intermediate Design for all Disciplines, Costume History and Décor, Rendering and Graphics, Costume Lab (Innovations), Industry for Design, and Professional Portfolio Seminar.
- Created online and Covid-19 adjacent curriculum so that our students could continue their education in a manner that allowed them to continue advancing without any pause. This included online portfolio reviews, interactive online labs and design courses, as well as one on one meetings with working designers to continue the student's connections to the world.
- Advised and mentored all costume design students on mainstage shows (Musical/Drama/Film/Dance). This included but was not limited to: weekly meetings with students to discuss process, shop meetings with students to assure process was running smoothly, attended select fittings to address these experiences, attended production meetings when needed, attended tech days with students, and participated in post mortems for students/faculty/advisors.
- Created curriculum staple workshops a year that became staples in the curriculum. These workshops
 included Portfolio/Website and Resume Building, Costume Innovations, Entertainment Taxes, Union
 rules and regulations, Textures in Costume Design, 3D printing for Costume Design, Costume Bibling
 and Wardrobe Paperwork.
- Started the Costume Lab at PACE. This is a design lab that creates a space for the costume designers to be a self-starter. We created a physical space so that designers can work outside of the shop during off hours.
- Created online reference points and databases, for PACE costume design students, to share inspiration
 and ideas that they came across, expanding the departments visual growth. This allowed an additional
 source of communication and exploration of what is impacting the profession.
- Worked with students to build our post-graduation success through portfolio reviews and showcases.
- Worked with the Production Manager and Head of Production and Design to create an advising guideline that allowed advisors and the shop staff to co-habitat and always be connected on what is to be expected from the students.
- Set students up with yearly internships with theater companies and independent designers for outside classroom learning. I set up revolving internships that our students use every year.
- Worked with the Head of Production and Design on recruitment by holding recruitment workshops. In these workshops, potential students would be treated to a 2-hour mini class where they would be immersed in our program and be able to ask questions to better understand what they were applying for.
- Worked closely with the Head of Production and Design, to create and craft the costume design program curriculum. Our goal was to create a program the set our students off on the right track and gave them every opportunity to work at the highest reaches of their capabilities.

 Courses included subject matter of textiles, art basics, costume design, fashion design, art theory,

UPCOMING PUBLICATIONS/RESEARCH PROJECTS

The Road to Design in Commercial Theater-(WORKING TITLE)—I am currently in the process of writing a "How To" book about how to begin your career in the Commercial Theater world. I am always asked how I started and any advice I have for young designers. I began to look at the literature we have available and realized there was none for designers. Every designers journey is so different, that it causes for some confusion on how and where to start. The book will document an overview of initial starting points for designers right out of undergraduate school. Topics like marketing yourself as a designer, showcasing your work, working with experienced peers, how to manage personal life with work, and much more. Through my work with Off the Lane, I have had the pleasure of mentoring students and contributing to this Non-For-Profit organizations mission of creating helpful mentorship into the industry. This book was inspired by what I was seeing and the work we need to do in order to truly help our students succeed.

Young Designer Community Database-(WORKING TITLE)—Through my work developing curriculum designed to launch seniors into the industry, I found that many are not prepared to truly tackle the industry. I find that this is due to lack of continued community going into the hustle and the bustle. This prompted a new research/passion project that I am currently working on. The goal is to create a virtual world that connects students, from all over the country, to other students in order to explore and have conversations about design and create community that helps not only while in school, but after. I have found that students go through most of their education in a bubble to the world around them. This largely hurts their ability to be inspired by the world. With this online database, students would be able to connect with other design students that are working on similar projects, share ideas, share imagery, and have a support system that was peer based, and not just faculty based. Another large aspect of this project is mentorship and community. We as an industry, do not have a standard of how we "release" artists into the industry and this causes a lot of stress and frustration amongst young artists. By creating a peer community that is diverse and regional, we allow our student to acquire connections that are not dependent on professors and schools alone. Project is still in development and I hope to be applying for grants within the next year and be supported by my educational home.
